

STEUBEN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING  
June 24, 2015

The Steuben County Commissioners met at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 24, 2015, in the Commissioners' Room of the Steuben Community Center. Present this day were Commissioners Ronald L. Smith, James Crowl and Lynne Liechty. Also present was Eric Ditmars, County Park Superintendent.

Ronald Smith stated that the Commissioners conducted interviews on Monday, June 22, 2015, for the new County Park Superintendent. Commissioners Smith stated that they met with seven (7) individuals and met some very nice people during those interviews.

Ronald Smith stated that the Commissioners will now consider who they will be hiring as the new County Park Superintendent; however, for the sake of protecting of the identity of the individuals, the Commissioners will be using the numbers of the application. Commissioner Smith explained that notification needs to be sent out to the applicants before the applicant's name is put on the radio or published in the paper.

Ronald Smith asked James Crowl and Lynne Liechty to eliminate four (4) of the seven (7) applicants.

Lynne Liechty stated she would like to eliminate applicant three (3), applicant one (1) and applicant five (5). James Crowl stated that he would like to eliminate applicant six (6). The Commissioners agreed upon the applicants to be eliminated.

Ronald Smith asked, based on the information received from the remaining three (3) applicants, who would the Commissioners like to nominate for selection as the new County Park Superintendent? Lynne Liechty stated that she would select applicant seven (7). James Crowl stated that he agrees with that nomination.

Lynne Liechty made a motion to offer the County Park Superintendent position to applicant number seven (7). James Crowl seconded that motion and the motion carried with three (3) ayes.

Ronald Smith stated that applicant seven (7) shall be notified. The other six (6) applicants shall be notified that they were not selected for the position.

Ronald Smith stated that once the applicants have been notified, Erin Wray, Commissioners' Secretary, will notify the press.

James Crowl thanked Eric Ditmars for 12 ½ years of wonderful service. He further stated that Mr. Ditmars and his wife have done a wonderful job as County Park Superintendent and Assistant County Park Superintendent.
